

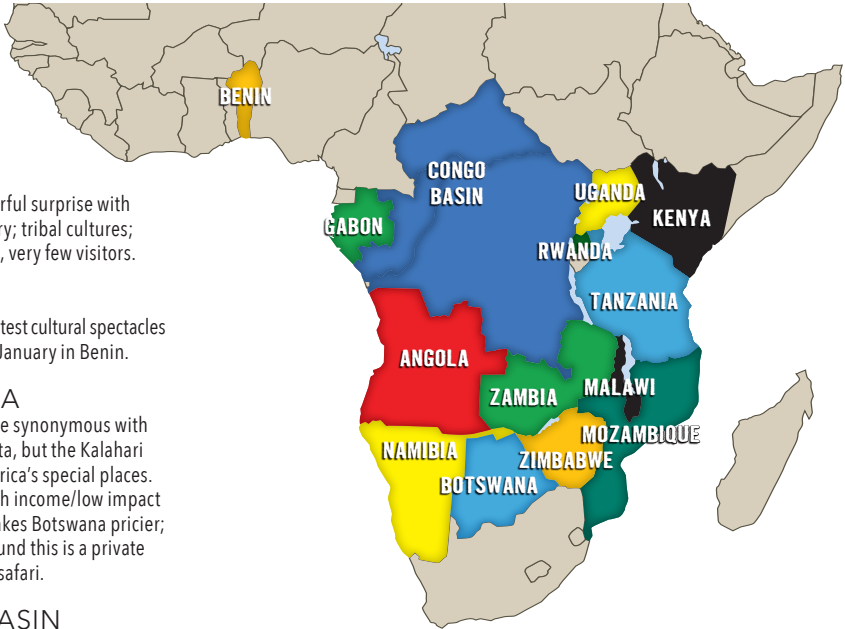

ANGOLA
